

Fundraising Terms and Conditions

Charity Place Agreement:

- By registering for the event you are agreeing to raise the minimum sponsorship pledge (excluding Gift Aid)
- Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable
- Before registering for the event you should be fit to participate or should seek medical advice if necessary.
- You agree to inform the event organisers of any relevant existing medical conditions, and any which arise after registration, which might affect your participation in the event.
- You will need to complete an online registration with the event organiser if needed and accept that failure to do so by the deadline may result in your place being lost.
- All sponsorship should be sent to NET Patient Foundation within 6 weeks of the event.
- You will contact NET Patient Foundation immediately if you need to withdraw your place.
- All sponsorship raised from the event are solely for NET Patient Foundation.
- You agree to NET Patient Foundation using photographs of you from the event to publicise future events and the work of the charity.

Fundraising:

- You should only use lawful means to fundraise for NET Patient Foundation and should not do anything which could potentially harm the charity's reputation.
- Your fundraising cannot include door to door collections, street collections (without first obtaining written consent from the local authority), collection on private property (without first obtaining written consent from the property owner) or conducting a raffle or lottery at a public event.
- If you are using NET Patient Foundation's donation tins, buckets or sponsor forms then all the money collected must be donated to NET Patient Foundation.

Health and Safety:

- If you are planning an event then you will need to ensure that your safety and the safety of those taking part is of the utmost priority and that a risk assessment has been completed, if necessary.
- If you are undertaking a physical fundraising activity then you should consult your doctor and ensure that it is safe for you to take part and you should train for the activity accordingly.

Personal Data:

- All information provided by you to the NET Patient Foundation will be securely kept on the NET Patient Foundation database.
- We will not share your details with anyone, in accordance to UK law.
- We may use your name, pictures, feedback and comments in any future publicity or fundraising materials, including on the internet and social media.
